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Dear WHP Neighbors,

I wanted to first say that I hope this letter finds you healthy and well. I also want to be clear with you on our perspective for postponing the May meeting and the Election. Our intention, as a BOD, first and foremost, is to do everything we can to protect the health of all owners. Our intention, in serving the community, is to do our best to advocate for and protect our WHP and your *informed* voice, in ALL situations.

In light of Coronavirus, and restrictions, we have made the decision to postpone our May meeting. There are owners interested in meeting and hearing from all candidates running for our BOD. There are some unanswered questions that folks would like the opportunity to address. We have worked to preserve this process of hearing from candidates by postponing the May (Town Hall) Meeting to 30 days after Stay-At-Home and assembly (gathering) restrictions are lifted.

We have also decided to institute a Q&A for owners to ask questions to the candidates offering to serve our community. We are not sure, yet, exactly how this will be conducted, but we will be careful and considerate of all involved when coming up with our plan. (*See ELECTION BULLETIN for more information*)

JUST an FYI- I have consulted with our attorney about other options, and I have learned that to separate the Election from the Annual Meeting, we would need an amendment to the by-laws. I have learned that all large associations, that he represents, are facing the same problem we are facing. In his opinion, the Board came up with a reasonable plan for rescheduling the meeting based upon the lifting of restrictions on travel and assembly.

Our goal, as ALWAYS, is to serve WHP well, and we are working as hard as we possibly can to protect the voice of each lot owner, in the upcoming election, and in the future that we face as a community.
