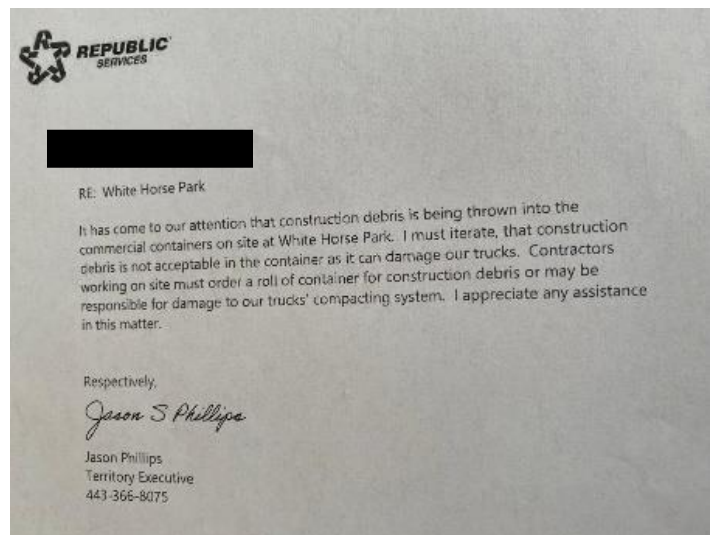
Laundry Facilities
