Favorite Recipe-

Wine Cake

- Preheat oven to 325 degrees
- Grease and flour Bundt cake pan
- Sprinkle bottom of pan w/ ½ c of chopped nuts (you can use any type/Tammy uses pecans)

Mix:

- 1 Duncan Hines Butter Recipe Golden Cake mix
 - 1 package instant Vanilla Pudding mix (larger box)
 - 4 eggs
 - ½ c. white wine (Tammy uses a good Moscato & drinks a glass to be sure it's good :)
 - ½ c. water
 - ½ c. oil
- Pour into Bundt pan and bake for 50-60 min.
(all ovens are different, so time may vary-the cake will start to pull away from the sides of the pan a little when it is done)
- Bring ¾ c. sugar, 1 stick butter and ¼ c. wine to a boil
(Tammy uses sweet cream salted butter)
- Pour over HOT cake
(Tammy pokes holes in cake with a kabab skewer before pouring over the hot cake)
- Let the cake sit for 20 min., then invert onto serving plate.



BIKES

Please follow the guidelines below:

- Bikes can be signed out for up to 3 DAYS ONLY.
- All children 12 and under MUST wear a helmet. If you have helmets at home, please bring them with you as we only have a limited amount to lend out.
- You must have an adult 18 years or older sign a release when you sign them out.
- NO bikes allowed off WHP property
- NO riding after dark unless you have a fixed light on your bike
- Observe the traffic signs
- WATCH OUT for cars and pedestrians.
- Enjoy the ride!

Homeowners, if you have a 20-inch or 26-inch bike with no hand brakes that you no longer want, please consider donating it to our bike loaner program. Thank you.
